
Lenten Reflection

2018 Sacrament Information

Please note the following dates for your diary. Parents need to attend the Parent Meeting for the Sacrament that they wish to enrol their child in. The table below is taken from the Pastoral Letter from the Parramatta Diocese and indicates whether your child is eligible to receive the sacrament in the Catholic Church. St Patrick's Parish Guildford follows these guidelines.



Penance

Who: Yr 2 children and those in Yrs 3-6 who have not received it.

Penance Parent Information Meeting: 11th April 6pm

First Penance is celebrated during school time as a class due to the nature of the sacrament.



Eucharist

Who: Yr 3 children and those in Yrs 4-6 who have not received it.

First Eucharist Parent Information Meeting:13th June 6pm

First Eucharist will be celebrated in the month of August. Dates will be allocated after the information Session.



Confirmation

Who: Yr 5 children and those in Yr 6 who have not received it.

Confirmation Parent Meeting: 22nd August 6pm

Confirmation will be celebrated on Saturday 4th November 6pm
