There are currently a number of cases of COVID-19 in Greater Western Sydney. As always, the health and safety of our school community is the top priority.

Please keep in mind that members of our school community may come into contact with people who are diagnosed with COVID-19 or be present in a location where COVID-19 is later identified. Of course, it's important we all follow closely the directions of the health authorities in these situations. **If your child is diagnosed with COVID-19, or is identified by NSW Health as a 'close contact' of a person who has COVID-19, please notify the school immediately.**

A reminder that anyone who attended Our Lady of Lebanon Co-Cathedral Harris Park on Wednesday 15 July at 5:30pm, Thursday 16 July at 6pm and Friday 17 July at 1pm and 6pm should immediately self-isolate for 14 days and come forward for testing even if they are not experiencing symptoms.

We take the care of our students, staff and families very seriously. We are continuing to reinforce the good hygiene and handwashing practices. We are also ensuring that the school is regularly and thoroughly cleaned.
